



Total funding raised (exc. exits) | annual



Total funding raised & Number of ventures raising \$1m or more (exc. exits) | annual




Total funding raised (exc. exits) | by semester



Total funding raised (exc. exits) | 12-monthly rolling periods




Equity funding in Africa reached \$1.5b in 2024 (-11% YoY)



Total funding raised (exc. exits) | by country



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

Total funding raised (exc. exits) | by region by year



Total funding raised (exc. exits) | by region by year






Total funding raised (exc. exits) | by region | cumulative 2020-mid 2022 vs. cumulative mid 2022-2024



Total funding raised (exc. exits) | by region | 12-monthly rolling periods




Eastern & Western Africa punch above their economic weight

Total funding raised (exc. exits) in 2024 vs. Population vs. Nominal GDP | by region





Total funding raised (exc. exits) | by region by year







Total funding raised (exc. exits) | Big Four vs. others | 12-monthly rolling periods





Total funding raised (exc. exits) in 2024 vs. Population vs. Nominal GDP | Big Four vs. others




The Big Four punch above their weight, especially Kenya

Total funding raised (exc. exits) in 2024 vs. Population vs. Nominal GDP | by country






Share of Big Four in regional total funding raised (exc. exits) 12-monthly rolling periods



Total funding raised in 2024 (exc. exits) | by sector




The share of fintech in overall funding has been growing back

Total funding raised (exc. exits) | fintech vs. other sectors | by year




'Climate Tech' represented 32% of the funding raised in 2024


Total funding raised (exc. exits) | climate tech vs. others| by year









Total funding raised (exc. exits) | Top 10 raisers per year




Top 10 raisers heavily influence the sectoral split

Total funding (exc. exits) raised by ventures having raised \$100m+ since 2019 vs. the rest of the ecosystem






Investment in Female CEOs has never been so low




Female founders have never been so underrepresented


Total funding raised (exc. exits) | share by gender mix of the founders | 12-monthly rolling periods


Total funding raised in 2024 (exc. exits) | by CEO gender & gender mix of the founders



Start-up funding in Africa in 2024: Key take-aways

- African start-ups raised \$2.2b in funding in 2024, a -25% YoY drop.
- However, the second half of the year outperformed both H1'2024 and H2'2023
- **Equity** 'only' dropped -11% YoY (\$1.5b) while **debt** levels contracted more significantly
- **Kenya** attracted the most funding (29%); 84% of the money went to the 'Big Four'
- Fintech was back on top, with 47% of the funding; climate tech (32%) did well, except for energy
- Half of the funding in 2024 went to the 10 companies that raised the most

- 2024 saw the minting of 2 new unicorns: Tyme and Moniepoint
- **Female-led** and **female-funded** startups received their lowest share of funding on record



- The number of active investors in Africa declined to its lowest since at least 2021; **54 Collective** was the most active investor
- Fquity funding dropped YoY in Africa, but bounced back in **LatAm** (9%), the **US** (21%) & **India** (+40%)

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
